How to protect survey marks

Survey marks are often located in road reserves, footpaths and other work sites – and some may be underground and easy to miss.

They're often damaged during construction and maintenance works such as roadworks, driveways, landscaping and underground services.

Plan ahead to prevent damage.

What you should do?

Check survey mark locations.

Use the South Australian Property and Planning Atlas (SAPPA) to see if survey marks are in or near your work area.

Contact early.

If survey marks may be affected, contact the Office of the Surveyor General before civil works begin.
